First, At a cost of \$150, they promise an evaluation in 3-5 weeks and in my case it took nearly 9 weeks.
Next, after receiving and reviewing the evaluation, the company added things to it that were not ever disclosed and took things away from it that were disclosed. Specifically, they mentioned a beeper finder and a TV volume control in my device of which I never disclosed. Also, in the evaluation they mentioned that I had not done a patent search or applied for a patent of which I disclosed to them I had in Oct. 2001. I also sent them my attorneys address and other related paperwork.

All I received was a cut, copy and paste document that is sent to all their customers as a patent evaluation.
Finally, they sent resources (internet sites) that could be contacted and specifically one of them (lambertfunding@venturemap.com) is not even a registered website or E-mail address.
