TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

THIS LETTER IS A COMPLAINT REGARDING INVENTION SUBMISSION CORP. ATTACHED IS A COPY OF THE LETTER TERMINATING THEIR SERVICES ON MY BEHALF. THE ATTACHED LETTER IS ALSO A DEMAND FOR THE RETURN OF THE MONEY I HAVE PAID TO ISC. THIS LETTER HAS BEEN COMPLETELY IGNORED AS OF THIS TIME.

I RECENTLY BECAME AWARE OF THE FTC RULING AGAINST ISC. THAT INFORMATION AND LEGAL ADVICE MADE ME DECIDE TO TERMINATE ISC SERVICES.

THE FOLLOWING ARE REASONS I AM NOT SATISFIED WITH ISC:

1. THE 2 LISTS OF MANUFACTURERS DATED 5-7-98 AND 8-21-98, CLASSIFIED MY INVENTION AS AN APPLIANCE OR HOUSEWARE ITEM. MY INVENTION IS FOR [REDACTED]
2. I PICKED COMPANIES FROM THEIR LISTS AND CONTACTED THEM BY PHONE AND FOUND THE FOLLOWING:
  - A. NO ONE ADMITTED KNOWING OF OR DOING BUSINESS WITH ISC.
  - B. THESE COMPANIES DID NOT MANUFACTURE BY TYPE OF PRODUCT, AND THIS WAS EXACTLY WHAT WAS IN THE THOMAS REGISTRY.

I MADE NUMEROUS CALLS DURING THIS TIME WITH ISC COMPLAINING ABOUT THE ERRORS IN CLASSIFICATION. THESE CALLS WERE IGNORED AS WELL AS MY CONCERNS.

AFTER READING THE FTC RULING AND OTHER BAD PRESS ABOUT ISC AND OTHERS LIKE THEM, I HAVE DECIDED NOT TO ASSOCIATE MYSELF WITH ISC. THE ONLY ACCEPTABLE RESOLUTION TO THIS MATTER IS THE RETURN OF THE MONEY I PAID TO ISC.
